UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FALLS TO 7.8%

On Friday, the Department of Labor released its [monthly jobs report](#) showing the unemployment rate dropping to

7.8%

and private sector job growth for the

31st consecutive month

- **7.8%** unemployment rate is the lowest unemployment rate since President Obama was handed the keys to the White House.
- Last month, private business hired **104,000** new employees and in the last **2 ½** years our economy has created more than **5.2 million** new private sector jobs.
- Over the last **12 months**, nearly **2 million jobs** have been added to the economy. In the last year of the previous administration, the economy lost over **4 million** jobs.
- More jobs had been added during the summer than previously reported with **40,000** more in July and **46,000** more in August.
