

*WASHINGTON, D.C. – Today, after members of the Congressional Hispanic Caucus met with President Barack Obama in the White House to discuss immigration reform, Congressman Xavier Becerra (CA-34), Chairman of the House Democratic Caucus, released the following statement:*
