



Eagle Rock

Eagle Rock is a neighborhood in northeastern Los Angeles bordering the cities of Glendale to the north and west and Pasadena to the east. Major thoroughfares include Eagle Rock Boulevard, Colorado Boulevard, and Figueroa Street. The Glendale and Ventura freeways run along the district's western and northern edges, respectively. A massive boulder at the district's northern edge contains an indentation which casts a vaguely bird-shaped shadow on the rock at certain times of day; the neighborhood derives its name from this geological feature. Eagle Rock is home to many historic and architecturally significant homes, many done in the Craftsman, Georgian, Streamline Moderne, Art Deco and Spanish/Mission style.

Eagle Rock is home to [Occidental College](#) , one of the nation's top liberal arts colleges. [President Barack Obama attended Occidental](#) during his Freshman and Sophomore years. In addition, Eagle Rock High School was ranked one of the top 400 high schools in the United States in 2006.
